

BURDELL-HUNT MAGNET ELEMENTARY SCHOOL UNIFIED DRESS CODE FOR STUDENTS

All students attending Burdell-Hunt Magnet School must follow the unified dress code Monday through Thursday. Students may wear spirit wear on Fridays. Spirit wear consists of a Burdell-Hunt t-shirt and jeans. The dress code is not optional but mandatory for all students.

Students may wear:

<u>Shirts</u> must be white, khaki, yellow, gold, red, or black polo style (with collar and buttons). Shirts may be long or short sleeves. School T-shirts or school sweat shirts are permitted only on Fridays. Blouses with collars and turtlenecks are permitted. All shirts and blouses must be tucked in.

<u>Plain khaki, black, or navy pants</u> must fit at the natural waist line or no lower than two inches below the waist if designed that way. Low hip huggers and low rider pants are not allowed. Pants must be of an appropriate size and must be worn with a belt if belt loops are present.

<u>Dresses and Jumpers</u> must be in plain khaki, navy, or black (no more than two inches above the knee with no splits, slits, or openings). Pleated dresses and jumpers are permitted. Jumpers may be worn with blouses, shirts, or turtlenecks in white, khaki, yellow, gold or black.

<u>Skirts</u> must be in plain khaki, navy, or black. Skirts may be no more than two inches above the knee. Any open pleat, vent, slit or button opening may not be open more than the top of the knee. Pleated skirts are acceptable.

<u>Shorts and Skorts</u> must be plain khaki, navy, or black. They must be of appropriate size and no shorter than two inches above the knee.

<u>Sweaters/Cardigans/Vests</u> must be plain white, khaki, yellow, gold, red, or black. They must be appropriately sized and do not have to be tucked in.

<u>Shoes</u> may be of any color with properly sized shoe laces. All shoes must be laced, tied and/or fastened appropriately. All shoes must have full backs and enclosed toes. Athletic shoes are allowed. Students must wear socks, tights or hose with all shoes. Sandals, high heels, snow boots, and backless shoes are not permitted.

<u>Belts</u> must be worn with all pants, skirts, or skorts if belt loops are not present. Belts must be plain khaki, black or brown. Belts must not have words, pictures, or sayings on them.

Clothing with frayed ends, holes, fading, and camouflage will not be permitted.

All other items which in the judgment of the principal (or designee), which disrupt or distract from the learning process is not permitted.
